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

Application process

GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Stage one: Application form

- ▶ Create your account
- ▶ Choose your service line and location
- ▶ Ensure you have thoroughly researched EY, your chosen business area and location
- ▶ Identify your personal strengths and how they relate to the role you're applying for
- ▶ When filling out your details, please read the instructions carefully and provide all the details of your qualifications - make sure to proofread your form!

Stage two: Online assessments

- ▶ Technology is changing our world - but how is it affecting the way people work?
- ▶ Explore this with assessments, multiple choice questions and a ranking exercise
- ▶ This can be done at your own pace, but we recommend you complete as soon as possible
- ▶ Take on a numerical reasoning test (NRT) which must be completed in one sitting
- ▶ Identify your key strengths - the things that you're naturally good at
- ▶ Receive personalised feedback on the strengths you displayed in the test - and the ones you can improve on

Stage three: Job simulation

Want to know if you're right for the programme you've applied to? That's what Stage 3 is all about.

- ▶ Use real work-based scenarios to explore different aspects of your potential role and how your individual strengths will fit at EY
- ▶ There are 14 questions in total for this stage
- ▶ Answer a mix of 14 multiple-choice, written and video questions
- ▶ There's no time limit, but it must be completed in one sitting
- ▶ On average, this stage will take around 45 minutes
- ▶ We'll share personalised feedback that identifies your key strengths for the world of work, how you can develop them further, and tips and ideas for the strengths you can improve on

Stage four: EY Experience Day

- ▶ Now a virtual experience
- ▶ You'll have 48 hours to respond to the invitation and confirm your attendance
- ▶ We won't be able to move the date of the EY Experience Day - this is fixed based on the programme and location you applied to
- ▶ On the day of your virtual EY Experience, you'll take part in a number of activities
- ▶ During the exercises, you'll be required to use a webcam facility in order to interact with your assessor
- ▶ The day is designed to see if you have the strengths needed for your role at EY but it's also a chance to see if EY is right for you
- ▶ You'll receive all the details of the day closer to the time

Stage five: Final interview

The final stage of the process is a final interview with a senior representative from the business. In light of recent developments regarding Covid-19, all final interviews will now take place virtually using video call technology.

You'll take part in a short discussion and talk about your motivations for the role you've applied for.

We'll be in contact with you soon after to let you know if you've secured a role with us.
